**Is there something else that you would like to try, perhaps something that has to do with dancing?**

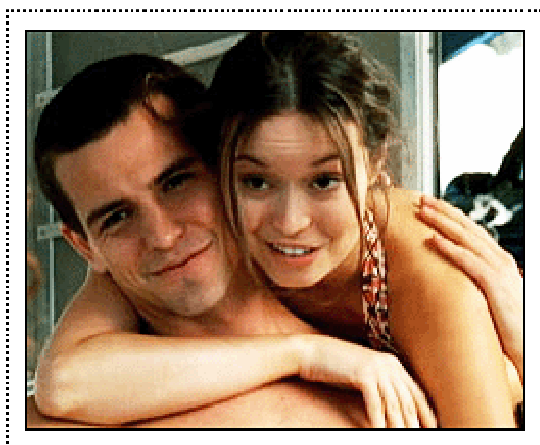
I daydream about being a chef...or a cowgirl.
